- Thursday** **Family night with evening meals commencing at 6.00 pm**
With 12 year and under children's meals half-price.
Children's entertainment also provided.
- Friday** **Evening meals commence at 6.00 pm, final order 8.50 pm**
with adjunct \$1 raffles available.
\$50 bar tab draw for all members, free registration at the bar drawn at 7pm.
